# A Transforming Faith

#### Mark 9:2-10 (NLT)

<sup>2</sup> Six days later Jesus took Peter, James, and John, and led them up a high mountain to be alone. As the men watched, Jesus' appearance was transformed, <sup>3</sup> and his clothes became dazzling white, far whiter than any earthly bleach could ever make them. <sup>4</sup> Then Elijah and Moses appeared and began talking with Jesus. <sup>5</sup> Peter exclaimed, "Rabbi, it's wonderful for us to be here! Let's make three shelters as memorials — one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." <sup>6</sup> He said this because he didn't really know what else to say, for they were all terrified. <sup>7</sup> Then a cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my dearly loved Son. Listen to him." <sup>8</sup> Suddenly, when they looked around, Moses and Elijah were gone, and they saw only Jesus with them. <sup>9</sup> As they went back down the mountain, he told them not to tell anyone what they had seen until the Son of Man had risen from the dead. <sup>10</sup> So they kept it to themselves, but they often asked each other what he meant by "rising from the dead."

### Thoughts & Questions to Fuss With:

- 1. Why do you think Jesus only chose Peter, James and John to go with him?
- 2. Explain the significance of the appearance of Moses and Elijah.
- 3. Describe the appearance of Jesus when he was transfigured?
- 4. In verse 5, Peter offers to build the three shelters, yet in verse 6, Mark noted that, "he (Peter) did not know what to say; they were so frightened". Why do you think Peter offered to build the shelters if he was so scared?
- 5. Describe a time that you were in God's presence and did not know what to do?
- 6. Why do suppose Elijah and Moses did not stay on the longer?
- 7. Why did Jesus give the disciples orders not to tell anyone?
- 8. What is one word you would use to describe the TONE of the passage (i.e. stern, joyful, cautious, etc.)?
- 9. What is one word or idea from the passage that stands out to you?
- 10. What is something from the passage that still confuses you?
